

Taylor & Francis Group/Consortia License Agreement

This agreement is made and entered into this 2nd day of May, 2011 (the "Effective Date" between Taylor and Francis Group and the Council of Prairie and Pacific University Libraries (COPPUL) Consortium ("the Licensee").

The Consortium, acting as agent, signs this agreement on behalf of the Consortium Members listed in Exhibit B and agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions of this License. The Consortium Members will then be granted the use of the Licensed Materials to any Taylor & Francis Reference Online titles set forth in Exhibit A and others that may be added to the list of online publications from time to time and by amendment at a later date.

DEFINITIONS

In this License the following words and expressions shall have the following meanings:

'Authentication System'

An Authentication System satisfactory to the Licensor, by which the Licensee will ensure that only Authorized Users are given access to the Licensed Material electronically online.

'Authorized User'

Individuals who are granted access to the Subscriber's information services available through a Secure Network, who are either (i) full- and part-time students and/or employees (including faculty, staff, affiliated researchers, independent contractors and temporary staff, and retired faculty and staff with Emeritus or equivalent status) or in some other capacity whereby they are permitted to access such services in the Subscriber's ordinary course of business, regardless of the physical location of such persons, or (ii) are physically present on the Subscriber's premises.

'Intellectual Property'

Copyright database rights, patents, design rights and trademarks whether registered or unregistered, and all other industrial or intellectual property rights existing in any jurisdiction, and all rights to apply for the same.

'Licensor'

Taylor & Francis Group LLC, whose registered office is at 6000 Broken Sound Parkway, NW Suite 300 Boca Raton, FL 33487, United States which expression shall include any publishing imprint subsidiary to or associated with the Publisher and the Publisher's administrators or successors in business as the case may be.

'Member'

COPPUL member library or affiliate member library participating in a license, as detailed in the attached Exhibit B.

1. FEES AND PAYMENTS

Taylor and Francis Group will invoice the Licensee all fees and charges pursuant to the pricing and terms set forth in Exhibit A. Licensee agrees to pay Taylor and Francis Group within 60 days of receipt of invoice. Fees and charges are non-refundable, except as provided herein.

2. USAGE RESTRICTIONS

- 2.1 Nothing contained in this License gives the Licensee or any Authorized User any rights in the Intellectual Property or confidential information of the Licensor in the Licensed Material.
- 2.2 The rental, loan or hire purchase of the Licensed Material, save with the express consent of the Licensor is prohibited without the express permission of the Licensor.
- 2.3 Any electronic distribution or dissemination of the Licensed Material is prohibited save as expressly permitted by this License.
- 2.4 Any alteration, amendment, modification or deletion from the Licensed Material, whether for the purposes of error correction or otherwise.
- 2.5 Neither the Licensee, nor any Authorized User, shall store transiently or permanently on any medium, transfer, transmit, reproduce, loan to any third party, publish or otherwise exploit, modify, or create derivative works from, or combine with other material, the Licensed Material except to the extent necessary to exercise the Rights granted by this License. For the avoidance of doubt, neither the Licensee nor any Authorized User shall use the Licensed Material in whole or in part for the purposes of electronic inter-library loan, or any external commercial re-use. The Licensee may, however, print out limited portions of the Licensed Material for the purposes of research or private study and not for Commercial use.
- 2.6 Nothing in this Agreement restricts the rights of Authorized Users under the doctrine of "fair use" as defined under the laws of the United States or as permitted under "fair dealing" under the laws of Canada.

3. TERM AND TERMINATION

- 3.1 This License shall commence on the Effective Date, upon completion of the Registration Details and payment of the subscription fee and shall (subject at all times to earlier termination in accordance with the provisions of this License) remain in effect for the License Period. Thereafter, this Agreement may be renewed for successive one (1) year periods, in accordance with this agreement and subject to the payment of all fees required thereby.
- 3.2 This License may be terminated with by either party if the other party commits any material or persistent breach of any term of this License. In the event that Taylor & Francis terminates this Agreement for reasons other than your breach of this Agreement, you will be refunded the pro rata portion of any subscription fees you have paid
- 3.3 Upon termination of this Agreement, you agree to continue to adhere to the provisions of this Agreement relating to any Taylor & Francis Intellectual Property.

4. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE LICENSOR

- 4.1 The Licensor shall:
- 4.1.1 Grant to Members of the Consortium, subject to and in accordance with the terms of this License, the non-exclusive right to permit Authorized Users to access and use the Licensed Material at the sites of Members or remotely, through secure authentication.

4.1.2 use commercially reasonable efforts to maintain adequate Internet or online connection and server capacity to provide the licensee with access to the Licensed Material;

4.1.3 provide the Licensee with all information necessary to access the Licensed Material online;

4.1.4 use all reasonable endeavors to restore access to the Licensed Material as soon as possible in the event of an interruption or suspension of availability.

4.2. In consideration of the payment of the Electronic Subscription Fee and of the agreement by the Licensee to abide by the terms of this License, the Licensor will, on the completion by the Licensee of the Registration Details and payment of the Electronic Subscription Fee, grant to the Licensee for the License Period the Rights.

4.3 The Licensor reserves the right at any time to withdraw from the Licensed Material any component included in it:

4.3.1 if the Licensor no longer retains the right to publish such component;

4.3.2 if at the Licensor's sole discretion the Licensor believes that there is at least a reasonable chance that publication of it would amount to an infringement of copyright database right defamation or any other unlawful act.

5. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE LICENSEE OR AUTHORIZED USER

5.1 The Licensee shall provide Registration Details, including a list of valid IP addresses for Authorized Users who will access Licensed Material from or via the Secure Network or Secure Server at the Site (where access via IP address is the required Authentication System) or remotely from outside a secure network or secure server.

5.2 The Licensee or Authorized User shall use reasonable efforts to ensure that only Authorized Users are permitted access to the Licensed Material and that all Authorized Users abide by the provisions of this License;

5.3 The Licensee or Authorized user retains the non-exclusive, non-transferable right for the License Period in relation to the whole or any part of the Licensed Material, to allow Authorized users to access the Licensed Material and to print and/or download on authorized computers no more of the Licensed Material than is covered by Fair Use.

5.4 Access and use the Licensed Materials from the premises of the Participating Member, or remotely via secure authentication, in order to search, retrieve, display and view the Licensed Material.

5.5 Create persistent links to individual articles for access by Authorized Users for Permitted Uses under this Agreement, from within secure authentication environments.

5.6 Interlibrary loan by paper or electronic means, a single copy of an individual document within the guidelines of traditional interlibrary loan practices and applicable copyright laws.

5.7 Scholarly sharing. Authorized Users may transmit to a third party colleague in hard copy or electronically, minimal, insubstantial amounts of the Licensed Materials for personal use or scholarly, educational, or scientific research or professional use.

5.8 A link to the Licensed Material may be incorporated in Electronic Reserve collections or Electronic Learning Environments.

6. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Licensee acknowledges that all copyrights, patent rights, trademarks, services marks, trade secrets and other intellectual property rights relating to the Licensed Works are the sole and exclusive property of Taylor and Francis and that this Agreement does not convey to Licensee any right, title, or interest therein except for the right to use the Licensed Works in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

7. LICENSOR'S WARRANTIES AND LIABILITY

If any provision of this License is found to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of law of competent jurisdiction, such a finding shall not affect the other provisions of this License and all provisions of this License unaffected by such a finding shall remain in full force and effect.

This License may only be varied in writing by means of variation signed in writing by both parties.

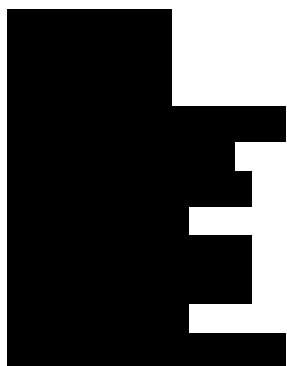
