

## Terms of Use

By navigating on the Curio.ca website, you agree to comply with these terms of use, the general terms of use for CBC websites ([found here](#)), as well as all applicable laws for such navigation. The terms of use may be amended from time to time, so please come back to review them periodically.

### 1 – Site to be used exclusively for educational and non-commercial purposes

#### a) General access – in educational institutions:
